The Indian Government's decision to consolidate 29 central labour laws into four labour codes has been welcomed by 90 per cent of people across industries and they believed that these reforms were long overdue and would bring about policy changes that would be beneficial in hindsight for both employees and establishments.

Recruitment firm Genius Consultant conducted a study among 996 senior management people from across sectors including Banking & Finance, Construction & Engineering, Education/Teaching/Training, FMCG, Hospitality, HR Solutions, IT, ITES & BPO, Media, Oil & Gas, Pharma & Medical, Power & Energy, Real Estate, Retail, Telecom, Auto & Ancillary.

When asked their opinion on the implication it will have on labourers' 'Right to Strike', over 60 per cent of people believed that the new provision would be beneficial for establishments that have now prohibited strikes and industrial lock-out without prior notice. However, 40 per cent of respondents differed to agree on the same.
